The FAA-certified AMT program at Gavilan College trains students in airframe and powerplant maintenance, and also offers an associate degree with a major in aviation.

Recruitment is underway for the Fall semester.

Gavilan instructor Herb Spenner will share information about the need for AMTs, the current job market/opportunities, FAA requirements and training options, the program at Gavilan, how to reach out to future mechanics. There will be time for questions and answers.

We meet this evening at the Gavilan facility at San Martin Airport, and Herb will provide a tour after his presentation.
